Terms and Conditions

Definitions: "CQU" Central Queensland University

All Vice-Chancellor's Scholarship recipients are governed by these terms and conditions.

- The Vice-Chancellor's Scholarship is awarded, at the discretion of the University, to exceptional students, undertaking formal on-campus full-time undergraduate or postgraduate coursework degree study at the following locations:
 - Central Queensland University Rockhampton Campus (international applicants only).
 - Central Queensland University Gold Coast International Campus (all applicants).
- The Vice-Chancellor's Scholarship is not available to students currently studying at CQU or in conjunction with any other CQU scholarship.
- The Vice-Chancellor's Scholarship is not transferable to a third party.
- The Vice-Chancellor's Scholarship remains valid whilst the recipient:
 - Remains enrolled in full-time study at the campus listed on their Letter of Offer and;
 - Remains enrolled in the program listed on their Letter of Offer and;
 - Pays all additional fees and other costs according to CQU policy and;
 - Meets the conditions of their student visa (if applicable).
- The Vice-Chancellor's Scholarship will lapse if the student named on the Letter of Offer:
 - Does not demonstrate satisfactory academic progress. Satisfactory academic progress is defined as the recipient achieving a pass/credit level at the first attempt in each and all of their courses for the duration of their degree program;
 - Graduates from the nominated program; or
 - Cancels their enrolment at CQU.
- The Vice-Chancellor's Scholarship will be renewed term-by-term subject to the recipient meeting all other University requirements.
- The Vice-Chancellor's Scholarship is:
 - Calculated on a per term basis;
 - Not redeemable for cash.
- A Vice-Chancellor's Scholarship may be withdrawn with 10 days written notice, should the recipient breach any of these conditions.

Appeals

- There is no right of appeal should the applicant be unsuccessful in securing a scholarship;
- A student who has received a Vice-Chancellor's Scholarship, but is advised that CQU is withdrawing their scholarship, has 10 days to appeal the decision.

The Terms and Conditions may be changed at any time and the University will provide 12 weeks written notice to all Vice-Chancellor's Scholarship recipients.
